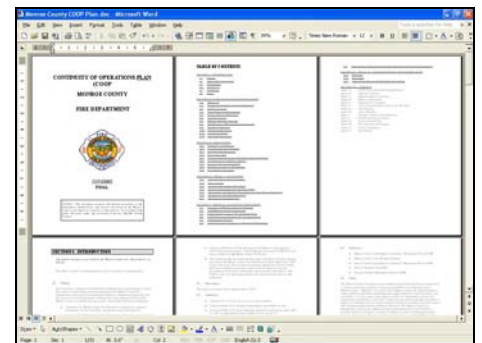

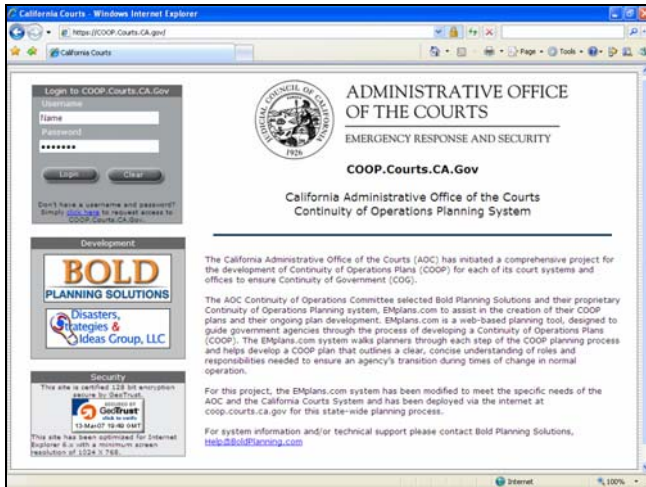

Superior Courts for State of California

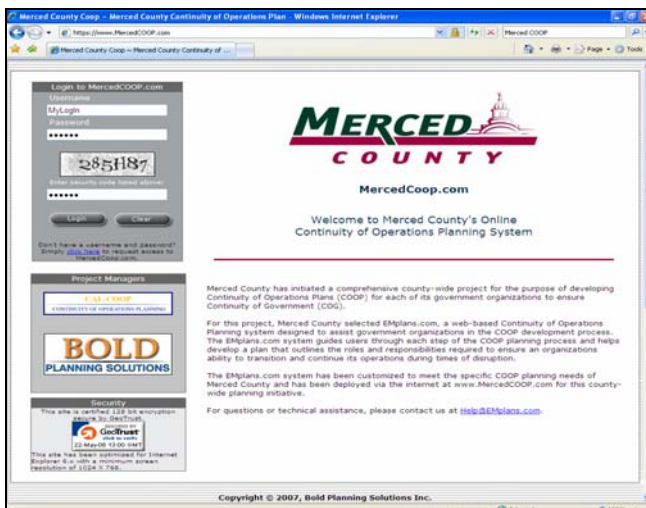
Official system used by all 57 Superior Courts within the State of California to create COOP and maintain plans for each of their departments and functioning units within the California court system.
